From a familial flat, this place is transform into a pied-a-terre apartment.

Partitions are totally demolished, according to the new program.

The flat is intended to welcome an art collection and is considered in a coherent esthetics marked with obvious facts.

The report is permanently joined to take advantage of the situation of expection.

Top of the range traditional materials complete the restructured set to put a robustness feeling and Parisian classicism timeless atmosphere.

The Breach Medicis, the nickel-plated brass and sycomore's woodwork, are raised by the use of silver leaf in the right side of the bathroom, where the shower offers a view on the Grand Palais.

Finally the dissimulation of service parts by the implementation of doors " under hanging " distorts not at all the quality and the technique of these secondary places offering the quality and the technique of our time.
