Perche Thironnais's sport center is a project with a particular symbolism.

Indeed, the construction's setting-up is situated in the entry of Thiron Gardais village, at the entry of the Naturel Park of Perche, near an abbey of XIIIth century.

The client insists on the architectural expression quality with also the high environmental quality.

The project follows this will, but it also aims toward an insertion in the urban site.

Then, the idea of a catcher on the urbanistic plan is retained. The notion of a soft, alive and natural monumentality is organized.

The program defines three principal zones: the Big room, the Dojo and the secondary premises. This classification expresses itself naturally under the shape of three volumes. Their size reflects their function.

Successive and thick pine nuts are treated with a bark of wood (essence of pine Douglas). They allow the blocking of the perpendicular facade which the treatment is in galvanized corrugated iron.

The North facade of the big hall is widely glazed by the implementation of a polycarbonate curtain.
